Heard 'Round The Pitch!

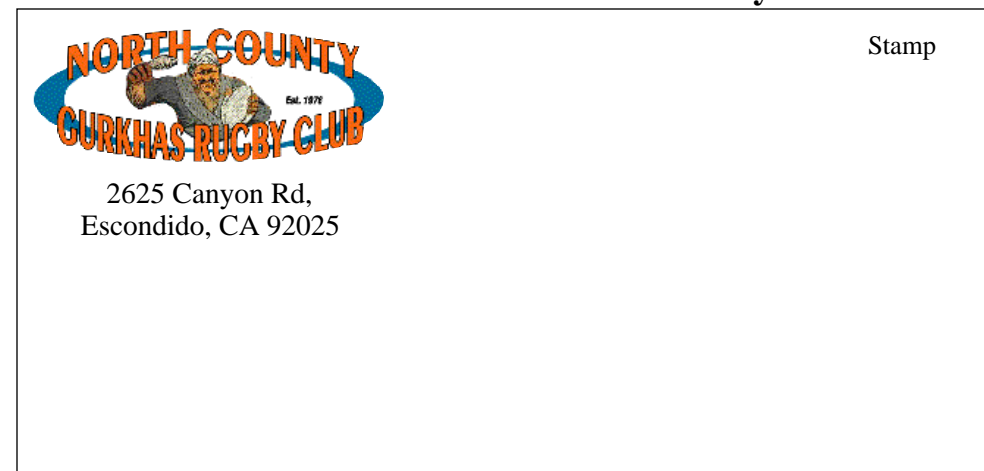
